

Factsheet 14 National Servicemen, Territorial Army and Reserve Forces **War Pensions Scheme only**

Were you injured or disabled as a result of your service in any of the above? If the answer is YES, you may be entitled to a War Disablement Pension.

A War Disablement Pension may be paid to ex-Servicemen and women who have an injury or disablement sustained as a result of Service. National Servicemen and ex-members of the Territorial Army and Reserve Forces do not have to have been involved in a war or have been on active Service when the injury or disablement occurred.

How to claim

You need to complete a form giving details of your Service and what injuries or disablement you want to claim for. You can get a claim form by calling the free Veterans Helpline - 0800 169 22 77.

What does Service Personnel and Veterans Agency do for me?

Service Personnel and Veterans Agency assists all former members of the Armed Forces – irrespective of whether they served in war or during peacetime, or were volunteers, reservists or National Servicemen – and their dependants.

Callers to the free Veterans Helpline can receive advice on a wide range of subjects such as Service records, medals, military graves and welfare issues. The Agency has close links with ex-Service organisations, voluntary groups or statutory bodies e.g. Social Services departments. The free Veterans Helpline is open Monday – Thursday 8:15am – 5:15pm and Friday 8:15am – 4:30pm.
